UNGER CHOSEN STATE BAR SECRETARY

Michael W. Unger, of Unger Law Office in Minneapolis, has been elected Secretary of the Minnesota State Bar Association. The office, which he assumed July 1, puts Unger on track to become the MSBA President during the 2015-16 bar year.
